PURPOSE

The purpose of this standing order is to provide guidelines for use of soap while washing apparatus on the pad in front of the Aid Building or anywhere else where soap may discharge into the storm water system.

STANDING ORDER

1. This standing order governs all volunteers and employees.
2. NO soap of any type may be used while washing apparatus in front of the Aid Station or anywhere else it may be discharged into the storm water system.
3. Only WATER may be used when there is any possibility of storm water discharge.
4. Since there are no soap filters on the storm water system in front of the building, the suds may drain into the bay from the storm water system.
5. If a piece of apparatus needs to be soap washed, tell the apparatus officer or maintenance technician. Arrangements for the apparatus to be washed in an environmentally safer area will be made.
6. Places where vehicles may be washed with soap include the car wash or the grass or gravel areas at SJI Fire Station 31.
